

Second Coordination Meeting on Linking Myanmar Standard Industrial Classification (MSIC) with ISIC Revision 5 held in CSO

The Second Coordination Meeting on Linking the Myanmar Standard Industrial Classification (MSIC) with the ISIC Revision 5 was held today at 10:00 AM in the meeting hall of the Central Statistical Organization, Office No. (32), Nay Pyi Taw. At the meeting, U Htun Zaw, Director General of the Central Statistical Organization under the Ministry of National Planning, Investment, and Foreign Economic Relations, made opening remarks.

The meeting was attended by 43 participants, including responsible officials from various departments, representatives from private business associations, and officials from the Central Statistical Organization.

In his opening remarks, Director General of the Central Statistical Organization stated that “Following the first meeting, the Central Statistical Organization (CSO) requested relevant departments and organizations to review and revise the translations prepared by the CSO for the newly added four-digit codes in the International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC) Revision 5, as issued by the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD), and to provide comments on the inclusion of additional five-digit codes. Comments were sought to related departments and organizations and this meeting is held to discuss and coordinate the comments and recommendations submitted by the respective departments and organizations.”

During the meeting, representatives in attendance exchanged views and held discussions on the comments made by respective departments and organizations.

The Director-General of the Central Statistical Organization subsequently coordinated and facilitated the necessary follow-up activities and requirements for the implementation of the MSIC Revision 1.
